Abstract:	Staff Week will be organized at the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences at the University of Split. Main idea of the Staff Week is to provide various insights and perspectives on the fostering educational excellence. In that process, special emphasis will be placed on analyzing and researching the quality of higher education from the perspective of transversal skills, which are recognized as important components of personal, social, and professional wellbeing. Participants will gain insights into various current topics such as inclusion, co-creation process between students and teachers, migration, development of critical thinking, social responsibility, etc. with the aim of improving the quality of the higher education process and the level of cooperation with students. Overall, the staff week aims to equip participants with a diverse set of knowledge and skills to enhance teaching quality, create inclusive environments, develop transversal skills and address various aspects that influence students' holistic development.
	The expected learning outcomes of the Staff Week are:
	Enhanced Understanding of Critical Thinking and Creativity:
	 Participants will gain insight into effective methods for encouraging students' critical thinking skills. Participants will identify strategies for fostering students' creativity.
	Elevated Teaching Quality and Institutional Standards:
	 Participants will engage in discussions on best practices to elevate teaching quality. Participants will gain insights into strategies for enhancing institutional standards to improve overall quality in operations.

	Improved Student-Teacher Cooperation and Transversal Skill Development:
	 Participants will develop understanding of different methods to strengthen cooperation and co-creation of students and teachers. Participants will explore different ways to develop transversal skills in students to better prepare them for future challenges.
	Cultivation of Inclusive Environments:
	 Participants will learn about creating and maintaining inclusive environments within educational institutions. Participants will discuss strategies for fostering acceptance of diversity and promoting inclusivity. Participants will identify practical steps to make educational institutions more inclusive.
	Impact of Family and Social Environment on Students:
	 Participants will explore influence of family and social factors on students' academic performance and well-being. Participants will develop tools for supporting students facing challenges in their family and social environments. Hidden Curriculum Awareness and Teacher Training: Participants will increase awareness among teachers regarding the importance of the hidden curriculum.
	Implementation of Sustainable Practices:
	 Participants will increase understanding the significance of sustainable issues in higher education. Participants will explore practical ways to integrate sustainable practices into educational institutions.
